**VOTER REGISTRATION:** Persons registered with the County Board of Elections (638-5172) or having voted in the school or general election in the last four years may vote without registering. **TO REGISTER** a person must be a citizen, at least 18 years of age and have resided in the District for a minimum of 30 days. Registration may be done in person until Thursday, May 15, 2008 at the Hilltop Administration Building, District Clerk Office, 13 A Dickinson Avenue, in Nyack from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday.

**BOARD CANDIDATES:** The petition deadline to appear on the ballot is **Monday, April 21**. Three at-large trustee positions, meaning a candidate does not run for a particular seat and the candidates receiving the most votes win, will appear on the May ballot. Three year terms begin on July 1, 2008.
